DIRECTIONS

Montrose Hideaway Bed-and-Breakfast Retreat may be tucked away, but it is easy to find.

It is located in the Montrose Historic District of Fairhope on Main Street (Scenic Highway 98) next to the Daphne city limits.

From U.S. Highway 98 heading north from Fairhope: After leaving Fairhope, turn left at the intersection with U.S. Highway 104. When coming to a two-way stop, continue straight. This will put you on Main Street (Scenic Highway 98). Continue 2.4 miles to our entrance on the left. (Our driveway is the next possible left after seeing North Winding Brook on your left and the Daphne city limit sign on your right.) Turn left into our driveway where you see our bright-blue sign and split-rail fence. If coming in after dark, it's helpful to know that a 20-mph curve sign on the right points to our driveway entrance on the left and that there is a fire hydrant next to our driveway, so a blue reflector in the road marks the spot. And if we've had a sunny day, the sign should be illuminated with solar lighting.

From I-10 onto U.S. Highway 98 East heading south toward Fairhope: Take Exit 35 for Spanish Fort, Fairhope and Daphne, heading south on U.S. Highway 98 East. Go approximately 5.5 miles to Ryan Avenue (the first street after mile marker 41) and turn right. (There is a Mazda dealership on the corner.) Go to the end of Ryan Avenue and turn left onto Main Street. The entrance to our driveway is on the right exactly 2/10 of a mile from Ryan Avenue. Turn into our driveway where you see our bright-blue sign and split-rail fence. If coming in after dark, know that our driveway is slightly before a 20-mph curve sign and there is a fire hydrant next to our driveway, so a blue reflector in the road marks the spot. And if we've had a sunny day, the sign should be illuminated with solar lighting.

NOTE: You can't see the house from the road, so follow the long drive back to the house. At the end of the gravel drive, follow the arrows directing you around the circle to the main entrance of the house for check-in. You will be told where to park after you have checked in.
